SIMI VALLEY FREEDOM WALK TO COMMEMORATE 9/11

What: The Ronald Reagan Presidential Library is joining forces with MilitaryConnection.com to bring to our city the **second annual Simi Valley Freedom Walk**. Please join us as we remember the victims on the sixth anniversary of September 11th, and honor our troops and Veterans on our second annual walk. A short program prior to the walk will include Terry Kraft, Captain of the U.S.S.
